The first is the search after the Sophist, the second is the enquiry into the nature of Not-being, which occupies the middle part of the work. For Not-being is the hole or division of the dialectical net in which the Sophist has hidden himself. He is the imaginary impersonation of false opinion. Yet he denies the possibility of false opinion; for falsehood is that which is not, and therefore has no existence. At length the difficulty is solved; the answer, in the language of the Republic, appears tumbling out at our feet. Acknowledging that there is a communion of kinds with kinds, and not merely one Being or Good having different names, or several isolated ideas or classes incapable of communion, we discover Not-being to be the other of Being. Transferring this to language and thought, we have no difficulty in apprehending that a proposition may be false as well as true. The...
